## A. BSoM Strategic Planning

- Dr. Painter: ACCME awarded our CME program 'Accreditation with Commendation,' which will be for a six-year period. This is the first time our school has earned this recognition. This level of recognition is significant because it requires demonstrating compliance in 22 criteria and only about 21% of ACCME-accredited providers nationwide earn this distinction.
- Dr. Painter: The next ACGME institutional accreditation site visit has been moved to 2022 from the original schedule of the 2014-1015 academic year.

- Dr. Painter: Faculty & Clinical Affairs is hosting a Faculty Leadership Academy on October 9<sup>th</sup>. The intention is to hold one session per month for a half day. There are approximately 14 attendees.
- Dr. Roman: The American Psychiatric Foundation awarded "Helping Hands Grants" to two of our students, Ashleigh Welko and Jasmin Scott. They are developing a parenting program for young adults at Daybreak.
- Dr. Roman: Dr. Sabrina Neeley was selected for a Gold Humanism Scholarship to attend the Harvard Macy Institute 2014 Program for Educators.
- Dr. Adragna: Terry Oroszi helped to organize the FBI Academic Biosecurity Workshop that took place on our campus today. The FBI was very impressed with the turnout and the workshop went very well. The FBI showed interest in doing this or similar events with us in the future.
