- ❖ **MDConsult** - fulltext of over 50 current medical textbooks, 80 journals including "Clinics of North America"
- ❖ **FIRSTConsult** – for differential diagnosis, evaluation and management of medical conditions, patient education, procedure skills review, including a PDA download
- ❖ **Access Medicine** – fulltext of numerous medical textbooks, including Harrison's and a board review option
- ❖ **Access Surgery** – fulltext of surgery textbooks, including *Schwartz's Principles of Surgery* and *Zollinger's Atlas of Surgical Operations*, animations and videos of procedures, board review options
- ❖ **Access Emergency Medicine** – fulltext of emergency medicine textbooks, numerous images, videos, and animations, point-of-care treatment answers
- ❖ **ACP Medicine** – comprehensive textbook of internal medicine
- ❖ **Clinical Pharmacology** – drug info, comparison, interactions, adverse effects and more, **including a PDA download**
