Dr. Hart joined the faculty of the University of Chicago
Department of Pathology in 1991 as assistant
professor, and became a full professor in 2004.
He is chief of the gastrointestinal and hepatology
pathology section, and director of the fellowship
program. Over 20 graduates of this program
now work in academic pathology departments.

Education and Training

Dr. Hart graduated from the University of Iowa
Medical School in 1986. He completed his pathology
residency and gastrointestinal and hepatic
pathology fellowship at UCLA Medical Center.

Scholarship

A member of the USCAP Board of Directors, Dr. Hart
serves on its executive committee as vice president.
He also is the past president of the Rodger
Haggitt Gastrointestinal Pathology Society.

Research

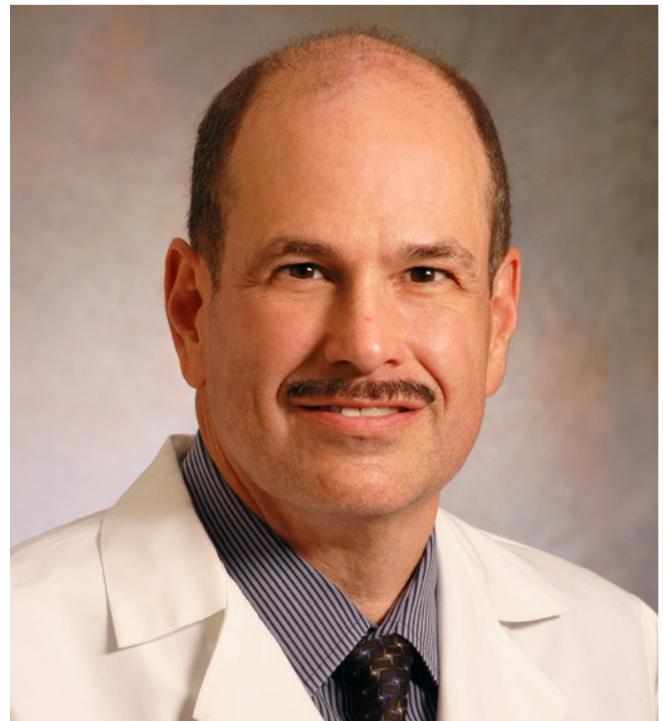
Dr. Hart has published more than 200 gastrointestinal
