2014 has been a remarkable year for the Department of Pediatrics. Highlights from this past year are outlined below:

- Dr. Arthur Pickoff retired after 16 years as Chair of the Department of Pediatrics. Dr. Pickoff assisted in the expansion of the department and through his numerous efforts directed us towards a more successful future. He was a superb mentor to numerous members of faculty, residents, and students. He will be missed by all and we wish him the best of luck in the years to come!
- Over 13% (12 of 91 matched students) of the class of 2015 will be entering residency training in pediatrics.
- BSOM faculty and members of the Dayton Children's Professional Staff continue to publish papers in excellent peer-reviewed journals and continue to be very visible at major national meetings. Pediatric residents and BSOM medical students participate in many of the research programs.
