Service Line Management:

In the role of Associate Chief Medical Officer, develop, streamline and supervise newly established service line structure for the hospital, with direct reports from 4 Service Lines (Respiratory, Hematology/Oncology, Clinical Divisions and Specialty Pediatrics) comprising of 14 divisions (Adolescent and Young Adults, Cardiology, Infectious Disease, Nephrology, Genetics, Endocrinology, Heme/Oncology, NICU, Transitional Care Unit, Pulmonary, Allergy/Immunology, Rheumatology, Sleep Medicine, Hematology/Oncology) focused on patient care, safety, quality, outcomes, operations, finance and experience

Clinically Integrated Network:

Helped establish Clinically Integrated Network of Dayton Children's Hospital (Dayton Children's Health Partners) in the role of the Chief Medical Officer in 2016, working with the Executive Director in communication, reach out, and setting quality metrics for the participating providers. Also helped with first Value Based contract with Anthem and realized our first shared savings 3rd year into our contract.

Establish the value based care model for Dayton Children's hospital working closely with the institutional leadership

Patient and Family Experience:

Closely work with the patient experience team at Dayton Children's Hospital as the physician lead in improving experience for patients and families, lead the steering committee focused on this work, develop communication and onboarding materials for established and new physicians joining the Dayton Children's Hospital practice group. Utilizing QI methodology to analyze survey data as well as develop improvement strategies. Our efforts recognized by NRC Health as the "**most improved facility**" in 2018.

Other activities related to my specific role within the area of Patient and Family Experience include

1. Launch of **NRC Real Time** survey which is a shortened survey and deployed within 48 hours of a clinical encounter that can help gauge patient experience within real time and respond to feedback in real time.
2. Launch of a new patient experience survey tool/metric- **Net Promoter Score**- which assesses patient loyalty and not just satisfaction. Our scores compare favorably with peer hospital group.
3. Development and roll out of real time patient experience dashboards, both in the ambulatory and inpatient setting
4. Alignment of provider incentives with patient experience dashboards
5. Development of a coaching program for providers to learn best practices in communication and feedback gathering from patients. As part of this program, several providers have either shadowed me in clinic or I have personally shadowed them for observations or improvement opportunities.
6. Participation in a network of children's' hospitals focused on developing best practices and data sharing regarding

family and patient experiences, and serving as member of the Steering committee from 2019-2022.

7. Onboard all new hires on Patient and Family Experience as part of the orientation during “Above and Beyond Day”.

8. Physician champion for improving family centered rounds- re-focusing institutions’ efforts on providing family centered care and assessing improvement opportunities based on family and patient feedback

9. Monthly family rounding with the CNO for pulse check about their hospital stay as well as to gain insights directly from families about opportunities for improvement

10. Onboarding of all new providers (Physicians as well as Advanced Practitioners) to the patient experience tools and expectations.

11. Development and implementation of a Transparency Advisory Group (TAG) to assess provider driven appeals of patient experience feedback.

12. Instrumental in advocating and selecting a concierge service to cater to the different needs of the patients admitted as well as being seen in the outpatient setting at DCH

Inpatient Dyad Infrastructure:

Lead the development of the physician-nurse dyad partnership model of shared governance in the inpatient setting, developing dashboard of outcomes, quality, safety and patient experience, and communication strategies across the institution. Lead quarterly Dyad meetings, and monthly inpatient family rounds with the CNO

Faculty Development and Mentorship Program:

Serve as the Executive Champion for the revamped mentorship program for newly recruited faculty members at Dayton Children’s Hospital. This is a unique initiative, serving as “connector” instead of a clinical or coaching mentorship program. The goal is to help new providers assimilate into the Dayton Children’s internal culture and the external community. Each new provider is paired with a seasoned providers/mentors, referred to as “Co-Pilots” We have developed a Co-Pilot/Mentor Job Description along with the Co-Pilot Checklist to help set the expectations up front. Additionally, a focused approach for development and career advancement of junior and mid level faculty has been established along 5 tracks (Clinical, Leadership, Organizational Excellence, Research, Education) within the

institution, and I serve on the Faculty Development Steering Committee.

Clinical Excellence

Executive Physician Champion for core group of programs focused on providing QI education, methodology and project involvement in care delivery and reducing patient harm. The core group comprises Quality Improvement, Quality Assurance, Informatics and Safety. Goal is to encourage transparency and inclusivity in what we do and are an accelerator for innovation and quality improvement within the organization. This also includes our QI course -Intermediate Quality Improvement Course- which is a 9 month long QI project based curriculum which has now graduated more than 100 matriculates since its establishment in 2016, and has now been rolled out to the residency program housed at the hospital as well.
