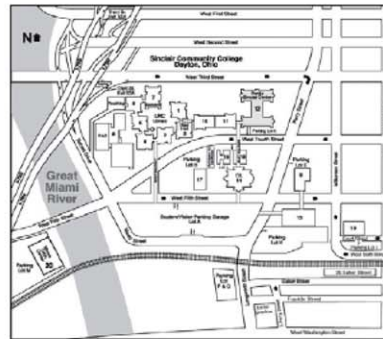
## Location
